arianne and her husband Pål didn't fall in love with their Fifties house at first sight. 'We bought the property in 2014 because we loved the location and could see that it had potential,' she says. The arrangement of the rooms didn't suit their lifestyle, so they embarked on a reshuffle. 'Our aim was to make the best use of the space,' explains Marianne. 'We moved the kitchen up from the basement level to the ground floor, where we created an open-plan kitchen, dining room and living room. It has brought more light into the whole house.'

The couple had a bathroom and a utility room fitted in the basement. 'The work took longer than I expected, so I had to learn to be patient,' says Marianne. 'You have to listen to the professionals and to think ahead when renovating an entire house, as you'll have to live with your choices for years. It's useful to write a list of your needs at the start and how they might change.'

Before deciding how to decorate the different rooms, Marianne waited to see how her family used them. 'I think it's important that rooms are multifunctional, so that the whole house is lived in,' she explains. 'For example, there's an awkward space off the ground-floor living room that I didn't know what to do with. I noticed my daughter Matthea played there a lot, so I decorated it so that it could be used as a playroom, with a big cupboard for her toys. It also gets used as an office, a quiet nook for relaxing and a spare bedroom for guests.'

Marianne keeps track of her ideas on her Instagram account, @inspirasjonsguidennorge, which has become one of the most popular accounts in Norway. 'It's full of the things I love about interior design,' she says. 'I also have a blog, mariannehagakinder.com. They're great ways to save ideas you love and evolve your home's style.'









Be colour consistent

The open-plan kitchen, living room and dining area share a grey colour scheme. 'I think it's important that the whole house is kept in the same palette,' says Marianne. 'I chose a very matt paint, which creates a soft, sophisticated look. The rooms are cosier and the mix of furniture and accessories shows up better against the dark grey background.'





Liz Silvester is the woman behind Liberty's spectacular


window displays, and if there's one thing she's learnt from 16 years in retail, it's that you can't rush perfection

aving previously created eye-boggling installations for Gucci, Prada, Selfridges and Harrods, Liz Silvester joined the team at Soho's Liberty in 2014. The biggest job on her 'to do' list is to co-ordinate the historic department store's legendary Christmas displays. She lives in a two-bedroom terraced house in Brighton with her cat, Lola.


Christmas at Liberty is always a mammoth project. This year, we built the window sets from scratch. and added chandeliers and claw-style lights to the building's exterior. The atrium is decorated in red-velvet swags to make it look like the Royal Opera House, and the whole ground floor is covered in garlands infused with Diptyque scents. There are 80 Nutcracker-inspired Christmas trees dotted throughout the store. Once everything is in place in early November, I relax and plan a holiday.

Friends often ask me to make them Christmas decorations.

I use whatever's lying around that is personal to them. They usually involve cuttings of foliage from the















garden, which we will go out and pick together, plus some fabric that I've brought along.

I have a ridiculous amount of fabric at home. I've collected it since I was a little girl. When I studied at the Royal Academy, Paul Smith donated around 70 rolls of fabric to help me build my coursework. Rolls and stacks of fabrics are a common theme in my house. The one thing that gives me most pleasure in my home is seeing a beautiful array of fabric on seating.

I live in a 170-year-old house in Brighton. When I bought it five years ago, it was a wreck and I've been fixing it up ever since. I took up the floorboards to put in new joists and replaced all of the windows with traditional sashes. Now I'm about to start decorating the inside, which is the fun part!

My house is a collection of all the things that I love.

There's no fixed trend or style; it's an extension of me and my personality. It's all quite pared back at the moment, but I'll be filling it slowly with all of my crazy furniture, collections of fabric, art and studio bits.

Start with a great base, like an amazing colour. It will be the backdrop you need to bring your objects to life, then you can build slowly from there. I'm a lover of colour and I'm not remotely scared to use it, but there's a limit, and in the past I've been guilty of pushing it too far.

My favourite room is my **bathroom.** It has a little window looking out onto the sea. With help from a plumber, I made the shower from reclaimed bits of pipe and hose taps from salvage yards. It looks like an outdoor shower, in copper and enamel. I plan to fill the bathroom with plants, from floor to ceiling.


Sacha, who is an interior designer (sachacoleinteriors.com), is used to working according to the tastes of her clients, so she relished the prospect of being 'let loose' in her own home. 'I wanted the house to have a welcoming, lived-in look, which I planned to achieve by using a limited overall colour palette and adding lots of personal touches,' she explains. 'It was important for the house to feel as light and open as possible without losing any of its warmth and character as a family home.'

Sacha commissioned a team of builders to knock through the groundfloor interior walls to create a large, open-plan kitchen, dining and living space. The tatty carpets were removed and the downstairs floors replaced with engineered oak. The dated bathroom fittings and kitchen units were upgraded and walls were stripped and reskimmed ready for painting, leaving Sacha a blank canvas on which to allow her colourful ideas and modern furniture shine. 'I chose fairly understated colours before adding lots of "zing" with feature wallpapers, blinds, rugs and soft furnishings,' she says. 'I love tropical shades – they're so uplifting and cheerful! I've used yellow, orange, green and red to create a bold, contemporary look.'

Much of the décor was inspired by a colourful picture that used to hang in the living room of Sacha's childhood home. 'It always reminded me of lazy summer days,' she says. 'Last year my dad gave it to me for Christmas. It completely ignited my passion for bright colours.'

Opening up the kitchen and replacing a dated conservatory leading of it with an orangery has transformed this part of the house, which is now Sacha's favourite place to be. 'I wanted the house to flow from one area to the next, rather than be a series of disconnected rooms,' she says. 'I've used similar tones and flooring but added lots of personal touches which have made our house a home.'



ntonia Hamilton inherited her garden flat in Edinburgh from her grandmother in 2008. 'She bought the flat in 1967 and I grew up just around the corner, so I have many happy memories of this place,' she says. 'The flat was converted in the Sixties and hadn't had much done to it in the meantime. The challenge was to alter it to fit our needs.'

Antonia's aim was to respect the flat's Georgian character and her gran's décor, while updating it to her taste and lifestyle. The tongue-and-groove panelling on the kitchen walls was retained, but its orange pine painted over. The ornate cornices, sash windows and shutters were highlighted with fresh white paint. Contemporary wallpaper was used to create feature walls that give definition to the large rooms.

The biggest change was the addition of a garden room at the back of the flat. 'I love the exposed stone of the original rear wall, which shows the property's transition from traditional Georgian to the new wood and glass of the extension,' says Antonia. 'We decided to hire an architect to design it and the investment was worth it in terms of the quality of the design, including glazing that wraps around the corner of the building and the huge skylight. The extension has transformed the way we live and it has become the hub of our home.'

Rather than try to re-create a period feel in this new space, Antonia has celebrated its modernity. A woodburning stove acts as the focal point of the room and a big, low-slung sofa signals that this is an informal space for relaxation and play with her sons, Eddie, Linus and Rollo. 'I can imagine them using this room as their own space to entertain friends in the future, and David and I will use the living area upstairs to relax,' she says. 'I can see this house evolving with us.'



HOW JULIA AND SEAN DID IT

'I wanted a family friendly kitchen where the children could run in with their muddy boots on or do their homework, and Sean and I could read or cook while the dogs mooched about. We employed an architect, Federica Vasetti of Dittrich Hudson Vasetti, and Sean took charge of the project management. The old units were moved into the living

room to create a temporary kitchen while the building work took place. We shopped around for units that would give us the modern-country look we wanted, and bought them at a bargain sale price. The build took three months and cost about £20,000, plus £4,500 for the architect. The whole family loves the new room – it's a dream come true.'

WHAT CLARE AND JAMES DID

'The previous owner had lived with a tiny kitchen on the first floor of this house, so we had nothing to work with on the ground floor. Initally, we set up a temporary kitchen, which was like a kitchen in a caravan. Then we knocked together the dining room and an old scullery to create one big space, and added bifold doors to flood the room with light. We ordered bespoke units to fit around the

original cornicing, picture rail and stained-glass window, and went for a modern purple island and splashback for the hob. The building work took about eight weeks and cost £49,000, and we spent £6,945 on the units, including fitting. It's a great space – in the summer we open up the bifold doors for barbecues in the garden, and in winter, we cosy up in here to watch TV.'

hen Liz Benson and her partner David decided to refurbish the kitchen of their Victorian terrace in east London, they were also keen to invest in new appliances. 'Since the arrival of our little boy, José, life has got a lot more hectic,' says Liz. 'Any technology that could help take the pressure off would be a godsend.' So how have her Beko appliances helped? We'll let Liz explain...

HOW DOES THE DAY BEGIN?

'José usually has us up at around 7am and we make a beeline for the kitchen. I'll grab him a cup of water from the dispenser in the fridge-freezer, then pop him in his high chair with some toast to

keep him amused while I make porridge. I do this on the induction hob, as it's so easy to control. You don't get any issues with the mixture burning, sticking or boiling over, as the cooking surface stays at a precise, constant temperature. It's also very quick to heat up, which anyone with a hungry toddler will know is essential!'

DESCRIBE A TYPICAL MORNING

'After breakfast, I'll pop all the dirty bowls and cups in the dishwasher to deal with later, and pop on some washing. We chose a washer-dryer, as we don't have space for separate appliances, but I wanted to be able to dry clothes whatever the weather. My machine can wash a full

load in under half an hour, so I can get lots of José's clothes clean in a hurry.'

DO YOU EAT LUNCH AT HOME?

'We eat lunch at home a couple of days a week. To make things easier, David and I batch-cook meals and keep them in the freezer, so we love that our Americanstyle model offers us a lot of storage. Our oven has a Split & Cook divider that separates it into two cavities so I can cook different foods at different temperatures at the same time, and with no transfer of flavours. This means I can bake cupcakes without worrying that they'll taste of José's favourite – fish pie. It's also got a genius self-cleaning function that makes it really



HOW IAIN DID IT

'Our old bathroom didn't have a separate shower – there was just one over the bath and, because it is in the eaves, we never had a screen or shower curtain. We just had to put towels on the floor! Eventually, this caused a leak, which initiated a redesign. At the top of our wish list was a walk-in shower, which had to go in the the right-hand corner, with the basin and loo alongside it. We had to have a plinth built

beneath the basin to conceal the pipes, so we decided to tile it and create alcoves for storage. A friend recommended Maciek Kocon at design and build company Magic Projects, who interpreted our ideas really well. The building work took three months and cost £10,000. I love the new look – in particular the patterns in the gorgeous stone basin and the recessed shelf in the wall above the bath.'

Make it work for you

IAIN'S CHOICE: A CURVED SHOWER TRAY

The right shower-tray shape can make or break your bathroom. Pick the perfect one for you with this simple guide...

You might not think there's much to picking the perfect shower tray, but in fact, from finding the right materials to fitting it flush to the floor, there's a lot to consider.

What size tray do I need? This depends on how big the bathroom is, but it's advisable to go as large as you can - upping the tray size by 100mm can make all the difference. If you find a cubicle claustrophobic but installing a wetroom would blow your budget, team an ultra-low-profile tray with a frameless enclosure for a similar feel without the bother or expense.

Which material is best? Acrylic is cost-effective, with 35mm-thick trays that sit flush with floor tiles for a seamless look. Resin trays are easy to clean, come in a variety of shapes, colours and textures, and can be cut in situ to fit against notches or angled walls

- but they're heavy, so you'll need a strong floor. Steel trays also come in lots of options, including flush-to-floor designs. Their smooth finish means they're very hygienic, plus they're supremely sturdy.

How are they installed? The tray should be one of the first things you install, so tiles can be laid over it for a watertight seal. Many trays can be fitted directly onto the floor or on a raised frame, creating space for waste plumbing. 'If a tray is installed directly onto the floor, it should sit on a bed of sand and cement so it's level and the underside of the tray is fully supported,' says Bathstore's chief marketing officer Claire Bayliss.

Will my fittings affect which tray I can have?

Wastes have differing limits on the amount of water they take away per minute, so if you're choosing a large showerhead, double check.






atasha Marshall and Neil Fullerton waited 13 years for the semi-derelict workshop and office building opposite their flat to come up for sale. 'We always said if it ever came on the market we had to have it – we knew it would make a great home in an ideal location for us,' says Natasha. 'When we opened the curtains one April morning in 2010 and saw the "For Sale" sign, we phoned up right then. Following a chat with the sellers and planners outlining our intention to convert the commercial property into a home, we submitted a successful bid.'

NEGOTIATING A PLAN 'Planning permission required us to demonstrate that we could approach the street in forward gear, so we had a turntable installed on the driveway,' says Natasha. 'It gave us the space for both a garden and a parking area. The hardest part was raising the necessary finances. As we were buying a commercial building, getting a mortgage for a residential building was very hard. We got there in the end.'

DESIGNING A DREAM HOME Natasha and Neil were involved in every element of the build. 'Our big idea was to get as much light into the building as possible,' says Natasha. 'We incorporated roof lights at the top of the building, so when you walk upstairs you're looking up at the sky.' The ground floor has a large open-plan kitchen, dining and living area, with a utility room and study off to one side. Upstairs, there are three bedrooms, each with a bathroom or en suite, and there's also a loft room with space for storage. 'From buying the property to completion of the build, the project took almost three years, but we're delighted with the result,' says Natasha.

Lighting design

1 IT'S WORTH PAYING
FOR AN EXPERT A lighting designer can transform a space and highlight key areas. Natasha and Neil's lighting is designed to subtly complement the natural light from their windows.

A HAVE THREE CIRCUITS 🚄 Each room should have three circuits: main overhead lighting, 5amp lighting for lamps and indirect lighting concealed in the architectural finishes. This gives flexibility in how you can light a space and you don't need individual dimmer switches.

O DOWNLIGHTERS WORK **OWONDERS** Recessed downlighters are ideal if you don't want your ceiling to look cluttered. Arrange in pairs or lines to avoid a 'scatter-gun' effect.

MIX YOUR LIGHTING... 4 Pendants work best over a dining table and at the centre of a living space, while concealed strip lights highlight architectural finishes, like fireplaces, as well as providing an ambient glow.

_ ...ON VARIOUS LEVELS O Low-level recessed lights subtly illuminate areas like stairs, without the need for harsh overhead lighting. They can also be used in the roof-light opening to illuminate this area at night.



HOW TO TRADE IN YOUR OLD PHONE

Yay, you've got a shiny new phone! But before you relegate your old handset to a drawer (or bin), consider trading it in instead. Even if it's been in the wars, you could get cash or a discount on your next device - plus you'll be doing your bit for the environment, too

Why should I trade in my old handset?

Unless you're giving your phone to a friend, trade it in. Brands such as Carphone Warehouse, Vodafone and Apple let you part-exchange an old phone for a new one - Apple currently offers up to £375, while Three pays up to £200. Otherwise, you could sell your phone to an online service, such as Mazuma or Envirofone. They'll give you a quote, send out a pre-paid padded envelope and, once they've received your device and are happy with its condition, you'll get the cash within a few days. Do shop around though, as prices vary from site to site.

What types of phones can be traded?

You'll get the most money for a working phone with little-to-no cosmetic damage. Broken phones are often accepted, too, and while you shouldn't expect much cash for them, they will at least be recycled properly. Unlocked phones also command higher payouts. If yours is 'locked' so it can only be used with a certain network, call your carrier and ask them to unlock it.

What should I include with my mobile?

You'll just need the handset and its battery. You can keep any chargers, cables or headphones it came with.

What will happen to my old device?

It could be used as a display phone in store or it might be refurbished

Ideal Home Tip

Don't forget to back up your photos and videos before you wipe your phone. Every handset differs, but there are great guides at three.co.uk that show you how to do it



- this is where the phone is cleaned, repaired and tested to make it usable again. Phones beyond repair are stripped down and recycled, rather than being sent to landfill.

What about my personal stuff?

Before you pass on or trade in your handset, perform a factory reset in case it falls into the wrong hands. This will remove any files, such as photographs, apps, music and text messages, and erase

personal accounts such as Facebook and Instagram. Here's how to perform a factory reset:

On iOS (iPhone or iPad): Go to Settings > General > Reset, then Erase All Contents And Settings. You'll also need to log out of your iCloud account, via Settings > iCloud > Sign Out. At the warning screen, press Sign Out again.

On Android: Head to Settings > Backup & Reset > Factory data reset. Scroll to the bottom and tap Reset Device, then Erase Everything.

Makes 20 Takes 30min

INGREDIENTS • 175g self-raising flour, plus extra for dusting • 75g lightly salted butter, cubed, plus extra for spreading and greasing • 1tsp Dijon mustard • 5tbsp buttermilk • 100g cooked ham hock, flaked • 6tbsp fruit chutney

- Preheat the oven to 220°C/425°F/Gas 7. Grease a large baking sheet.
 Put the flour and butter in a food processor, and blend until the mixture resembles fine breadcrumbs. Add the mustard and buttermilk, then blend until the mixture forms a dough.
- 2 Turn out the dough onto a floured surface and roll out until 2cm thick. Cut out rounds using a 4.5cm-round cutter and place on the baking sheet. Bake for about 12min or until risen and golden. Transfer to a wire rack to cool. To serve, halve and butter the scones. Pile a little of the ham hock onto each one and top with chutney.

Roasted scallops

Makes 12 Takes 25min

INGREDIENTS • 12 large scallops
A little vegetable oil, for brushing
4 spring onions • 4tbsp sweet chilli
sauce • 3tbsp chopped coriander

- Preheat the oven to 200°C/400°F/ Gas 6. Pat the scallops dry on kitchen paper, brush with a little oil and season. Heat a frying pan and sear the scallops on both sides to colour. Transfer to a roasting tin. If the coral is not firmly attached to the scallop, cut it away and place on top.
- **2** Bring a pan of water to the boil. Halve the spring onions and cut lengthways into fine shreds. Simmer in the pan for 2min to soften, then drain and dry them on kitchen paper.
- **3** Roast the scallops in the oven for 10min. Meanwhile, mix the chilli sauce with the coriander. Spoon a little sauce onto each scallop to serve. Bundle up shreds of onion and place



on top of the scallops, pushing wooden cocktail sticks through the onion and scallops to hold together.

Scotch quail eggs

Makes 12 Takes 45min

INGREDIENTS • 12 quail's eggs
Plain flour, for dusting • 400g sausage meat • 1tsp fennel seeds, lightly crushed

- ½tsp cumin seeds, lightly crushed
- 1 red chilli, deseeded and finely chopped 3tbsp chopped parsley
- 1 egg, beaten 75g breadcrumbs
- Vegetable oil, for frying
- 1 Put the quail's eggs in a pan. Cover with cold water and bring to the boil. Reduce the heat and simmer for 2min. Drain, rinse in cold water and peel. Roll the eggs in the flour to dust.
- 2 Mix the sausage meat in a bowl with the fennel, cumin, chilli, parsley and some seasoning until evenly combined. Divide into 12. Take a piece of sausage meat and flatten it out with your fingers to about 5mm thick. Use to wrap around an egg, pinching the edges together so the egg is enclosed, and roll in the palms of your hands. Repeat with all the eggs. Dust with flour, then coat in the beaten egg and breadcrumbs.
- Heat a 5cm depth of oil in a frying pan until a piece of bread turns golden in 1min. Cook the scotch eggs in batches, lowering into the pan and frying for 5min until pale golden. If the breadcrumbs brown quickly, lower the heat so they don't overcook. Serve warm or cold, cut in half.



Watercress soup with smoked trout

Makes 1ltr (enough to fill about 10 espresso cups) **Takes** 30min

INGREDIENTS • 50g lightly salted butter • 3 shallots, roughly chopped • 2 medium potatoes, peeled and diced • 1ltr vegetable stock • 250g watercress, roughly chopped, tough stalks removed • 5tbsp crème fraîche • 75g smoked trout fillets

- I Melt the butter in a pan and gently fry the shallots for 5min. Add the potatoes and stock, and bring to the boil. Reduce the heat and simmer for 15min or until the potatoes are tender.
- 2 Add the watercress and cook for 1min, then whizz with a stick blender until smooth. Stir in the crème fraîche and season. To serve, pour into cups. Shred the trout and place on top.

Baby roasted potatoes with herb salt

Serves 8 Takes 1hr 10min

INGREDIENTS ● 500g new potatoes • 2tbsp olive oil • 2tbsp crushed pink peppercorns • 2tbsp each of chopped thyme, parsley and chives • 40g sea salt

- Preheat the oven to 200°C/400°F/ Gas 6. Toss the potatoes in the oil and roast for 1hr or until golden, turning once or twice during cooking.
- 2 Mix together the remaining ingredients and place in a small dish. Serve the potatoes with cocktail sticks for dipping into the herby salt.





Gingerbread rum punch

Makes 1 Takes 10min

INGREDIENTS • 2 fine slices of peeled root ginger • 1tsp clear honey • 50ml gingerbread rum • Half a fresh lime • Dash of sugar syrup • Ginger ale

- Bash the ginger in the base of a cocktail shaker with the back of a spoon. Add the honey and the gingerbread rum, then stir until the honey has dissolved.
- **2** Add two squeezes of lime juice, the sugar syrup and ice. Shake to combine, then strain into an ice-filled tumbler. Top up with the ginger ale.

Dates with bacon & goat's cheese

Makes 18 Takes 15min

INGREDIENTS • 18 plump dates • 50g smoked streaky bacon, finely chopped • 1 garlic clove, crushed

- 100g smooth mild goat's cheese
- Slice the dates through to the centre and remove the stones. Fry the bacon in a dry pan until crisp and golden, then set aside and leave to cool.
- 2 In a bowl, combine the bacon with the garlic, goat's cheese and plenty of black pepper. Stuff a little of the mixture into each date and serve.

Salted caramel popcorn

Serves 10-12 in small cones Takes 20min

INGREDIENTS • 1tbsp vegetable oil • 50g popping corn • 50g unsalted butter • 75g light muscovado sugar • 2tbsp golden syrup • 1tsp vanilla extract • ½tsp sea salt flakes

- Line two baking sheets with baking parchment. Heat the vegetable oil in a large pan with a tight-fitting lid. Tip in the popping corn, cover with the lid and heat until the popping stops, shaking the pan frequently - this will take about 5min.
- 2 Melt the butter in a separate pan and add the sugar, golden syrup and vanilla extract. Heat very gently until the sugar has completely dissolved. Raise the heat and let the syrup bubble for about 4-5min until darkened to a rich caramel colour. Pour the syrup over the popcorn and stir well until combined.
- **3** Tip the popcorn onto the lined baking sheets and spread out in a thin layer. Immediately sprinkle with the salt flakes and leave until completely cooled. Break up any pieces that have stuck together and store in an airtight container for up to two days.

Elderflower Martinis

Makes 2 Takes 10min

INGREDIENTS • 100ml elderflower liqueur, such as St-Germain

- 100ml gin 4 dashes of lemon juice
- 2 green olives, for garnishing
- Put the ingredients in a cocktail shaker with plenty of ice. Shake well.
- 2 Strain into two Martini glasses and garnish each one with a green olive.

Classic cheese straws

Makes 50-60 Takes 40min plus chilling time

INGREDIENTS • 125g plain flour, plus extra for dusting • 100g lightly salted firm butter, cubed, plus extra for greasing • 125g mature Cheddar cheese, grated • 1 egg yolk • Pinch of cayenne pepper

- I Grease two baking sheets. Put the flour into a food processor and add the cubed butter. Blend until the mixture resembles fine breadcrumbs.
- **2** Add the cheese, egg yolk and 2tsp cold water. Blend again until the mixture comes together as a ball of dough. Wrap and chill for 1hr.
- **3** Preheat the oven to 190°C/375°F/ Gas 5. Roll out the dough on a lightly floured surface until about 5mm thick. Cut out sticks measuring about 9cm x 1cm. Transfer to the baking sheets, spacing them slightly apart, and sprinkle lightly with cayenne pepper. Bake for 18-20min until golden. Transfer to a wire rack to cool.

Christmas shortbread

With their delicate rose and almond flavour, these melt-in-the-mouth biscuits would make a lovely gift or tree decoration

Makes 22-2<mark>4 b</mark>iscuits Takes 50min plus chilling time

INGREDIENTS

- 150g plain flour, plus extra for dusting • 25g ground rice
- 125g firm slightly salted butter, diced ½tsp rose extract
- 75g caster sugar Small handful of unblanched almonds
- Decorations, such as white icing, white sugar sprinkles, edible pearls, gold food colouring, chocolate and nuts
- 1 Put the flour, rice and butter in a food processor and blend until the mixture resembles coarse breadcrumbs. Add the rose extract and sugar, and blend to a firm paste. Wrap and chill for at least 30min.
- 2 Preheat the oven to 180°C/350°F/Gas 4. Grease two baking sheets. Roll out the dough on a floured surface to 5mm thickness. Cut out shapes and space slightly apart on the baking sheets you could cut out stars from the middle of some rounds or press almonds into others. Use a skewer to make holes for hanging your biscuits.
- **3** Bake for 25min until just turning pale gold around the edges, re-marking the holes with a skewer if necessary. Cool on a rack, then decorate.



WHAT'S FOR DINNER?

Turkey & chestnut pie

Not sure what to do with those Christmas-lunch leftovers? Use them to rustle up this winter warmer



SERVES 4 **TAKES** 1hr 20min

INGREDIENTS • 50g butter, plus extra for greasing • 450g leeks, trimmed and cut into 1cm-thick slices • 2tsp thyme leaves • 50g plain flour • 500ml turkey stock • 300g cooked turkey, cut into large pieces • 200g cooked ham, cut into large cubes • 100g cooked chestnuts, quartered • 75g crème fraîche • Grating of fresh nutmeg • 350g ready-made puff pastry • 1 egg yolk, beaten

1 For the filling, melt the butter in a large saucepan or casserole dish, and add the leeks and thyme, then

stir, cover and cook on a low heat

- **2** Add the flour and stir well. Pour in the stock gradually, stirring until you have a smooth sauce.
- **3** Add in the turkey, ham, chestnuts and crème fraîche, then season with black pepper, a little nutmeg and salt, if needed. Stir well to combine.
- 4 Put the filling into a 30.5cm x 25.5cm pie dish. Preheat the oven to 200°C/400°F/Gas 6. Butter the rim of the dish. Roll the pastry out to the thickness of a £1 coin, then cut

out several strips and press them around the edges of the dish. Brush the strips with water and place a lid of pastry on top. Make two small holes in the lid to let the steam out.

- **5** Press the pastry edges together, trim off any excess, then knock up the edges and crimp. Use any remaining pastry to decorate the top of the pie. Mix the egg yolk with 1tsp water and brush over the pastry.
- **6** Place the dish on a baking sheet and cook for 30-35min, or until the pastry is brown and the filling piping hot. Serve immediately.
