SARAH'S STYLE RULES

I like a home to have depth and character'

Te moved into this house after outgrowing a two-bed terrace in another part of Leeds. We needed a place big enough for me to have a home office. The kitchen was small and the bathroom was accessed through a bedroom, but we loved the light and its peaceful location.

You have to bite the bullet when renovating. We spent five months redesigning the upstairs layout and revamped the kitchen. Later, we regretted not taking out a chimney breast in the middle of the space. We'd knocked out the walls either side, but it still felt like a room of two halves. We had an RSJ fitted and opened it all up. Suddenly, it was light and open and became one big party room.

We keep favourite everyday items out, to enjoy them. In the kitchen, we decided not to have too many units, because they can look overwhelming. We put up a shelf for all our crockery, instead. There's no point in buying nice plates or glassware and hiding them away.

We also like to collect things and display them. If you like something, you'll find a home for it. I treasure many of my grandparents' belongings, too, like the vintage suitcases once owned by my grandfather, in which I keep old toys, books and mementos.

Mixing old and new, modern and retro works, even in a contemporary setting. I get inspiration from a single piece of furniture and develop a room from that. I like a home to have depth and character. There are some things I've had for years and would never part with, and other

pieces we've bought recently. We don't want our home to be like everyone else's!

It's worth thinking outside the box and repurposing

items. If we need a coffee table, like the one we have outside, I'll cut down an old dining table. I sell things on eBay, too.

I don't follow trends that will be gone within a year. I would rather think creatively and long term. I love to experiment with bold and unusual design ideas or to marry modern urban chic with cool retro for an eclectic style.

I love bright statement colours.

I am fond of green and yellow, so it's a theme running through the house. I create a backdrop first – something neutral, which means the pops of colour look exciting.





iân designed textiles for Marks & Spencer, Dunelm and Debenhams before joining Asda in 2012. George Home was launched shortly afterwards and she now heads up a team of eight. She lives in Mirfield, West Yorkshire.

My house has changed a lot since I bought it two years ago. Back

then the decor was very Sixties – it had a peach bathroom suite, woodchip wallpaper and a stairlift. However, the rooms were big and, once the heavy curtains and pelmets came down, there was so much light. Even now, I still manage to find new ways to improve it. I'm always decorating and getting stuck into new projects.

I toyed with going dark in some rooms, but I knew I'd get bored.

It's nice to come home to a bit of calm after a day at work, so most of the rooms are painted in Valspar's 'Sleeping In', which is a white-grey. It gives me a blank canvas to furnish and accessorise however I like.

I'm a complete hoarder and collector. I have lots of accessories, cushions, throws, vases, frames, lamps, and so on. I'm constantly





moving things around the house and getting pieces in and out of storage. That's why neutral rooms work so well for me. It means I don't have to get my paintbrush out every time I want to change or refresh a space.

I've been collecting vintage mirrors for a while now. Bevelled designs with hanging chains are my favourite. You can get sets of new replica ones, but the original midcentury pieces have more charm. I think they look amazing hung together on one wall but they are so big and heavy, I've yet to get around to hanging all of my collection!

I have a real passion for house plants. I love bringing the outdoors in, so I have plants in nearly every room and some of them are really huge now! They look amazing in handwoven baskets.

The kitchen is probably the most transformed room in the house.

I updated it on a shoestring, so it's also had the least money spent on it. I painted the melamine cupboards black and found some copper handles that looked great against it. I also painted the brown tiles white and redid the yellow walls in Valspar's 'Magic Touch'. There was an old pantry in the corner, so I papered the back of it in palm-print wallpaper and painted the shelves black to create a home for my crockery.

At work, I like that there's no restrictions to my creativity.

I work across so many trends and seasons – I mean, where else could you buy a resin fox in a bell jar, a rainbow-shaped butter dish and a family of giant garden gnomes?!

We're constantly looking for new trends and ideas

I love to travel, but I love coming home, too. I live on my own, but the house is always full of family and friends. I enjoy having the girls over for a few Proseccos and a dance-off! I like to play the hostess, so having my house full of happy people is always a joy to me.

FIRST FLOOR

aving fallen for a quaint, red-brick Devon farmhouse, Emma Jaulin had a battle on her hands to persuade her husband Hendrik it would work for them. 'His first impression was "No way!" she says. 'He thought it was dark and cramped. Once we left, I started explaining how the ground floor could be opened up to bring in more light. By the time we got home, he was convinced. We'd seen nothing else with so much potential.'

The house had barely been touched for 20 years, and had tired decor and old-fashioned fixtures. Once Emma and Hendrik moved in, they stripped away the old carpets and wallpapers, and tackled the layers of old paint on the skirtings, dado and staircase. 'We spent every day sanding and painting,' says Emma. 'Although it was summer, we didn't relax in the sun even once. It was horrible, but we definitely learned a lot!'

They knocked through the kitchen and dining room, central passageway and sitting room to boost light levels and to create one multifunctional living space. 'The window frames needed replacing and we wanted minimal frames and maximum glass,' says Emma. 'UPVC would have jarred with the exterior, so we went for aluminium. We swapped the two back windows for much taller shapes, which make the interior brighter.'

Now, with the interior finished, the couple are looking to the future. 'We're expecting our first child soon,' says Emma, 'and the open-plan layout may not work so well as our family grows. With that in mind, we're planning to divide the room with a glass partition and sliding glass door between the dining and seating zones. It will give us separate spaces when we need them, without losing light or the open feel.'













Choose basic key pieces

Refresh old fittings

We couldn't afford to replace the kitchen,' says Emma, 'so I upgraded the worksurfaces, bought a new cooker and tiled the splashback with leftover bathroom tiles. The existing cabinets were made-to-measure and still solid, so I spent about £900 on a professional spray paint to extend their life until we're ready for a redo.'

of The location of this house is the perfect combination of social city living and urban oasis 99

ith its double-height ceiling, beams and open staircase, this house has the features of a spacious loft apartment, but tucked into the 109sq m confines of a cosy cottage. Built in the style of a typical Danish summer house, it is tucked away on the site of a former community garden in the heart of the city. 'Families live here all year round now, so we are close to our neighbours but we can also see the plants growing and hear the birds,' says Monika Pedersen. 'It's the perfect combination of social city living and urban oasis.'

Monika and her husband Henrik bought the house in 2010. Two years later, they started a two-year renovation project, living in one room with their children, Frigg and Falke, as the house was torn down around them. 'As soon as we started looking behind the walls, we realised the place was in a bad state,' says Monika. 'We had to rip everything out – walls, floors, windows. All that's left of the old house are the roof and rafters.'

The process allowed them to rethink the layout and make the most of the property's small footprint. The open-plan design offers long views through the house and an illusion of space. Look up and roof lights give a view of the sky. Gaze out through the French doors and picture windows and you'll see the garden. There's even a wraparound deck that's used as an extra room. Space, light, views – it sounds pricey, but that's not the case. 'I bought all the windows and doors from a recycling database where people sell glazing they've bought in the wrong size,' says Monika. 'Wherever I could, I bought reclaimed or second-hand materials; it saved us a lot of money. Each time we complete a project in the house, I'm grateful. We're living in our dream home!'







Keep kitchens simple

In an open-plan space, you have to decide what zone to make the focus. Monika has picked out the dining area, but chosen kitchen units that blend into the background, with black accents to give the all-white space structure.





avina Fox-Hill has lived in London and in the South of France, but the place closest to her heart is the coastal town of Whitby, where she grew up. So when a seafront flat came up for sale in nearby Sandsend in 2016, she snapped it up. 'No sooner had I bought it than the one next door also came up for sale,' she says. 'I realised I could dismantle the lot, link the two and start again.'

One of the flats had been modernised but wasn't to Davina's taste, while the other was dark, damp and very dated. 'I was able to live in one side while the other was renovated and then switch over,' says Davina. 'I have done up properties before, so am used to the chaos.'

Davina employed builders to strip every room back to a shell and remove walls in the front rooms, which overlook the sea, to make them more spacious. 'All the rooms were very small and cramped and I wanted to make everything seem bigger and flow together,' says Davina. Steel lintels were put in to strengthen the openings, leaking windows were replaced, new electrics and a central heating system were installed, and the unmodernised side was fitted with a new damp proof course. A wall was also taken out between two small bedrooms to create one large space.

'It took about four months to renovate the flat and we love being here now it's finished, whatever the weather. In summer, we throw open the doors and sit on the terrace where we spend hours watching the changing tides of the sea. While in winter, we batten down the hatches and stare at the dark skies from the comfort of the sofa. I still have to pinch myself sometimes. I've always loved the sea but I never thought for one minute that I would find somewhere as close to it as this place.'







HOW SUZANNE AND MARTIN DID IT

'We decided on a whole-house renovation, transforming the exterior of the house with New-England-style cladding, and chose Shaker-style units for the kitchen to suit that look. The traditional design has a timeless quality that won't fade with changing fashions. The space was originally two rooms, but we took down the wall and I designed the layout around the biggest island we could fit in. It makes a big

impact, so we kept the colour scheme subtle, which matches what we've used throughout the house – plus the white walls maximise the light levels. Our builder measured up the space and fitted the kitchen. The installation cost £1,500 and took just over four weeks to complete. The kitchen was just a small part of the whole project, but now the house is finished, this is definitely my favourite room.'





Make it work for you

SUZANNE'S CHOICE: COMPOSITE WORKTOPS

Like the look of Suzanne's sleek composite worksurfaces? Here's everything you need to know before you shell out...

It's easy to be overwhelmed with choice when it comes to choosing a worktop, but for a surface that's hard wearing and low maintenance, composite designs tick all the right boxes. There are two main types, quartz composite and acrylic composite.

How are they similar?
Both are man-made with
hard-wearing qualities, although
it's wise to use chopping boards
and trivets to prevent scratching
and heat damage. Quartz
composite is predominantly made
from quartz, resin and pigment,
while acrylic composite is made
from stone and mineral dust,
acrylic, resin and pigments.

So, what's the difference? Acrylic based composites are more flexible and can be seamlessly moulded to create curves and shapes, like integrated sinks with invisible joints that won't harbour germs. Quartz-based composites can be joined inconspicuously, but the connection between the two won't be invisible.

Is damage easily repaired? In the very unlikely case that your composite surface is scratched, chipped or stained it can often be repaired by a specialist. However, it is easier to achieve perfect restoration with acrylic composites as scratches can be sanded out, while quartz is more likely to be filled and any polishing can leave a dull area.

Are they expensive?
Yes, compared to laminates and wood. In some cases, composites can prove pricier than natural stone. Some brands are more expensive than others, often based on the quality of materials and manufacturing techniques. You can also bump up costs further by choosing fancy curves, outsized runs and multiple cut-outs for sinks and hobs.

Who will fit them?
Fabrication is done by specialists and usually arranged by your kitchen supplier.
Templates will be taken once the base units are in place and it can be one to two weeks before the worktops are ready to install.



'Alternatively use a waterproof remote control,' says Phillip Pini of Crestron EMEA. All bathroom electrics must conform to strict safety regulations.

Is there a cheaper option? Bluetooth speakers that stream music from a smartphone or tablet are our retro-fit friend. For safe bathroom use, they're powered by waterproof low-voltage transformers connected to shaver cables. The most common are in-ceiling speakers and those in mirrors and cabinets.

If I don't want to rewire? Go for a portable solution. There are plenty of waterproof Bluetooth speakers available and the humble shower radio, now with vastly improved DAB quality. is always an option. Try Fugoo's portable speakers (from £49 on Amazon), which run for up to 40 hours. Also, check out portable wi-fi speakers, like Denon's Heos 1 HS2.

Any other tech advice? To change tracks in the bathroom without fear of dropping your phone in the bath, go for a waterproof model when you next upgrade. This year sees a whole host of launches from the likes of Sony, Samsung and Apple, using the latest nano-coating protection.

What is an IP rating? IP stands for Ingress Protection, and any source of music in the bathroom needs it. Look for at least IP67 or IPX7. covering immersion; IP65 or IPX5, means splashproof. In-ceiling speakers not located above a bath or shower only need to be moisture proof so IP44 is sufficient.

fter extending and renovating their home, which took around nine months, Caroline and Tim Norris decided to take a break for a couple of years before turning their attention to the garden. 'We are both complete garden novices, so we really needed to think about what we wanted and do lots of research,' says Caroline.

The garden was a good size, stocked with mature shrubs and trees, but the couple rarely ventured past the patio seating area, which meant all that space was going to waste. 'We went to the Hampton Court Palace Flower Show as a starting point,' says Caroline, 'then we used Pinterest to find images to illustrate a wish list of what we had in mind for the garden.

'Luckily, we knew a landscape gardener, Simon Fraser, and trusted him to do a good job. Initially, we paid him a £500 design fee to plot out everything on our wish list. We tried not to be too prescriptive, so he had the freedom to come up with creative solutions and ideas that we hadn't thought of.'

Once the plans were agreed, the garden was cleared and the summerhouse was built, taking five days including one to lay the foundations. Simon did the rest, including the raised beds, outdoor kitchen, shed, wood store and planting. 'We wanted low-maintenance plants, especially various grasses, to create the Mediterranean look I had in mind,' says Caroline.

THE COUPLE SOUGHT DESIGN ADVICE as soon as they moved in. 'I had seen external makeovers by Back to Front Exterior Design (backtofrontexteriordesign.com) on television,' says Jo. 'They came up with some bold suggestions for us, including remodelling the front dormers with a pitched roof and cladding the whole house in composite weatherboarding. And replacing roof tiles with slates and fitting more traditional timber windows completely changed the exterior.'

HOW TO GET YOUR TECH REPAIRED

From coffee cups to last year's smartphone, there's no escaping the fact we live in a throwaway society, and while low prices make it tempting to buy new rather than repair broken items, sometimes you can – and probably should – do the latter...

My TV has broken - given how cheap they are now, is it worth getting it fixed?

If your TV is more than eight years old it's probably not worth repairing, but if it's more modern, call the manufacturer or a repair shop for a quote. You may also be able to see what the fault is via the service/fault menu screen.

What if something breaks when it's new?

You can ask the retailer for a repair or refund within 30 days. If it breaks within the first six months and the retailer can't prove that it wasn't faulty at the point of sale, you're entitled to a free repair or replacement. If they refuse, contact Trading Standards.

QIs there any way I can guarantee my stuff won't break in the first place?

It's impossible to know whether something will last for decades or not, but investing in a high-quality item usually ensures it'll give you many years of service. One example is Dualit's Classic toaster which, while expensive, can be repaired and should last for decades. For more investment buys, check out buymeonce.com.

Q I've smashed yet another smartphone screen, what's the best way to fix it?

Accidental damage is not covered by standard warranties, but there are lots of high street and online repair shops that specialise in screen repairs (try Geek Squad for official repairs). Stay clear of

unofficial third-party repair shops
– however temptingly cheap – to
avoid invalidating your warranty,
just in case your phone develops
a technical fault down the line. If
you're clumsy it might be worth
taking out insurance to cover drops.

What about DIY appliance or gadget repairs?

That depends on whether or not you're handy with a toolkit and don't mind potentially invalidating your warranty. You'll find hundreds of YouTube videos and unofficial repair guides online, such as ifixit. com, for mending most faults.

Is gadget insurance worth it? If you're prone to losing things it may be worth it, especially for larger items. While you can insure a bundle of small gadgets from just £40 to £60 per year, remember that the cost of the insurance plus any excess may work out similar to buying a replacement. Check your household insurance, too, as many policies offer gadget cover as standard, while many banks offer mobile phone insurance as a freebie.






















Pulled pork buns & tangy slaw

Takes 4hr 35min plus marinating & resting Makes 12

INGREDIENTS FOR THE SPICE RUB

- 1tbsp brown sugar 1tbsp sweet smoked paprika • 1tsp cayenne pepper • 1tsp allspice • 1tbsp ground black pepper • 1tbsp salt FOR PORK BUNS • 2kg boneless pork shoulder, rind and fat removed • 4tbsp oil • 2tbsp American mustard • 2 onions, sliced • 200ml cider vinegar • 200ml apple juice • 12 soft white buns FOR THE SLAW • Zest and juice 2 limes • 2tsp caster sugar • 1tbsp tomato purée • Few drops of Tabasco • 2tbsp barbecue sauce • 3tbsp mayonnaise • 1/2 red cabbage, shredded
- Mix ingredients for spice rub. Cut into pork sides so it opens out flat like a book, with a similar thickness all along. Rub with 2tbsp oil and the mustard, massage in spice rub. Chill overnight.

• 1/2 white cabbage,

shredded • 1 red onion,

sliced • 2 carrots, grated •

• Barbecue sauce, to serve

Bunch of coriander, chopped

- **2** Heat remaining oil in a frying pan and brown meat on all sides or cook over a hot barbecue until charred.
- **3** Put sliced onion in a large



roasting tin lined with baking paper, sit pork on top. Pour over vinegar and apple juice. Cover with parchment, wrap in foil and slow roast on the barbecue for 3-4hr until tender. Once cooked, rest for 1hr.

- 4 Strain pork juices into a jug, skimming off fat. Shred pork with two forks and spread in the tin. Drizzle with ½ the juices and return to the oven for 15min.
- **5** To make the slaw, whisk together lime zest, juice and caster sugar. Add tomato purée. Tabasco, barbecue sauce and mayonnaise, and mix until combined. In a large bowl, combine prepared vegetables and pour over dressing, tossing to coat evenly. Chill.
- **6** Serve pork in buns with chilled slaw and barbecue sauce on the side.

Grilled chicken & summery veg pasta salad

Takes 45mins, plus marinating Serves 6

INGREDIENTS • 4 skinless chicken breasts • few sprigs oregano, chopped • 3 garlic cloves, crushed • zest and juice 2 lemons • 3 peppers, quartered and deseeded • 250g orzo • 250g broad beans • 200g green beans, trimmed, halved • 150g feta



- 4tbsp extra virgin olive oil
- 1/2 bunch parsley, chopped
- handful mint leaves, torn
- I Put chicken in a food bag with the oregano, 2 garlic cloves, and zest and juice of 1 lemon. Season, seal the bag, massage the marinade into chicken. Chill overnight.
- **2** Remove chicken from the fridge 30min before cooking. Heat barbecue or grill to medium. Cook chicken for 10-12min until cooked through, then cut into chunks. Add peppers to grill for around 10min until charred. Remove and chop.
- **3** Cook pasta, adding beans for the last 3min. Drain and cool pasta and beans under cold running water. Tip into a bowl, crumble over feta, add chicken and peppers.
- 4 Mix remaining garlic, lemon zest, juice, oil, parsley and mint. Season, add to salad, toss, then serve.

Chargrilled sardines

Takes 20min Serves 4

INGREDIENTS • 16 sardines • oil, to coat • lemon wedges, to serve

■ Remove large fish scales by scraping a blade of a knife against the grain of the scales. Snip fins off with scissors, cut fish open along



the belly, from head to tail. Under running water, dig your thumb into belly by the tail end, scoop out the guts from tail to head. Bin guts, gently rinse and dry fish.

2 Toss each fish in olive oil. Put them on an oiled grill, season with salt, then grill for 1-2min on each side. Serve with lemon wedges.

Summer herb salad with **buttermilk** dressing

Takes 5min Serves 8 (as a side)

INGREDIENTS • 120g wild rocket leaves • Handful of mixed herbs, like fennel tops, parsley, chives or basil • 5 fat asparagus stalks, trimmed and shaved into long strips • 50g pumpkin seeds, toasted • Handful edible flowers (optional) FOR THE BUTTERMILK DRESSING • 200ml buttermilk • 100ml extra virgin olive oil • 1tsp Dijon mustard • 1tsp caster sugar Juice of ½ lemon ● 3tbsp finely chopped chives

- I Toss all the salad ingredients together.
- **2** To make the dressing, whisk all the ingredients together with a tablespoon of water and season to taste. Spoon the dressing over the salad to serve.
