Take a quick tour...



hen Pete Gardiner retired, he and his wife Amanda decided to look seriously at properties in Padstow, Cornwall, where they'd enjoyed holidays for more than 20 years. 'Padstow isn't huge and there are a limited number of old properties that are close to the harbour and restaurants,' says Amanda. 'We wanted estuary views and parking, too, so it was a tall order. But this was to be our dream home, and we were prepared to hold out until we found it.'

The couple discovered a ground-floor flat in a Victorian property that had been languishing on the market for more than three years. It needed renovating and had the added complication of sharing water and gas utilities with the neighbours, but the Gardiners decided to put in an offer. When the sale completed, the couple reassessed the scale of the investment they were

planning to make. 'The original intention was not to spend too much money, but we soon realised that we'd have to spend a lot more on it to get it how we wanted,' says Amanda. They refitted the kitchen and bathrooms, enlarging their en suite to fit in a shower, and replaced windows with French doors in the kitchen and one of the bedrooms, to let in more light and allow access to the terrace. At the same time, they replaced all the interior doors and radiators.

Pete took on some of the work himself. 'In winter, I camped out in the living room and it was freezing,' he says, 'but being on site was invaluable.' He's also been redoing the garden, which is on a steep slope: 'It had to be terraced and decked for us to be able to use it,' he says. Amanda loves the garden now. 'My favourite thing is to sit out there, with the sun going down, enjoying a glass of wine,' she says.













Add a beachouseinspired finish

Nothing says 'coastal' quite like clapboard, so Amanda and Pete chose tongue-and-groove panelled kitchen units in simple white.

Sam's tastes have changed

I find it hard to get rid of anything!

Her luxe homeware store is all about simple, upscale style - but Amara founder Sam Hood struggles to keep her own home uncluttered

am and her husband Andrew opened an interiors store in Chelmsford, Essex, in 2005, and quickly moved online. Amara.com made high-end brands such as Missoni Home and Ralph Lauren available nationwide, and now has its own-brand range, too. Sam and Andrew live in Essex with their two daughters, Lotty, 21, and Molly, 17.

Everything in my house has a story behind it, or reminds me of something or a place I've been.

The downside is that I find it impossible to get rid of anything! I suppose I'm a really emotional person when it comes to decorating my home. I decorate with my heart.

We have a special chair for my mum. She bought a rocking chair by the British designer William Plunkett and we stored it for her in our shed for about 15 years, by which time it had fallen apart! So I had it renovated and covered in gold leather as a surprise. I revealed it to her on Christmas Day. It's her chair when she comes to visit.

There's a real mix of things in my house. We have a grand piano and an Aga alongside Missoni rugs and leopard-print cushions. There are some things that you could say









you grow older. Your influences develop. Sometimes when I look back 10 years, I feel like, 'Wow, what on earth was I thinking when I decorated that room?!' But at the time, I loved it. I've gone from a house where every window had swags and tails in traditional patterns to what my house looks like now. Everything is plain, simple and neutral.

I use lots of black. Black sofas, in particular. My home is neutral with pops of colour from accessories. All the walls are painted in Farrow & Ball paint. My daughters' bedrooms are quite colourful in contrast with the rest of the house. Both feature really dramatic Cole & Son wallpaper.

We don't redecorate much, but I'm always moving cushions and throws around, or adding new ones here and there. How many cushions can I cram onto the bed, for instance? Which Andrew never understands! I remember Molly's school teacher once asked the class what their parents did for a living. The other kids were answering with things like, 'My dad's a lawyer!' or, 'My mum's a nurse!'. When it came to Molly's turn, she said, 'My mum and dad post cushions to people.' She was four when we started Amara, so she's never known anything different her entire life. The girls are very much a part of the business.

When Andrew and I started Amara, we struggled at first to find the right name for it. The shop was in Chelmsford, which is an old Roman town. We took the Latin name for a vaulted ceiling, which was Camara... but we didn't like the 'C', so we took it off and we were left with Amara. It's easy to spell and you're always at the top of everyone's list!



he Prestneys' previous home was a converted Victorian schoolhouse with period features, but with the imminent arrival of their first child, Kay and Andy decided they needed more space. Andy's mum spotted an Eighties house for sale and persuaded Kay to take a look. It lacked the character Kay loves, but was spacious and had lots of built-in storage, as well as a large, split-level living space with sliding doors leading to the garden.

They moved in just in time for baby Bella's arrival and, only a few weeks later, redid the bathroom and refreshed the kitchen by painting the existing units that were in good condition, and replacing both the flooring and worktops. The house worked well for a while, but in 2015, the family needed more space, so they added a wood-clad second storey over the living room. It gave them space for two rooms, but they opted for one, large, multipurpose space that serves as an office, guest room and second living room. 'As the build progressed, I loved the height of the room being created, but realised we could create even more living space and asked the builders to put in a mezzanine,' says Kay, who runs her own business (kinshipcreativedc.co.uk).

While the house was a building site, the couple decided to widen the steps between the split-level dining area and living room downstairs to create a more open feel. They also fitted a woodburner in the living room, which gave the space a focal point.

Ten years on, the house is a bright and cosy place. 'It reflects how we live as a family and it's a great place for entertaining our family and friends,' says Kay.

Repurpose and reuse

Kay simply repainted the existing kitchen units in a fresh Scandi grey. Using her collection of rustic chopping boards as display pieces has added warmth to the space, along with open shelving (below) made from scaffolding

planks left over from the building work, styled up with favourite crockery and plants.

ate and Andrew Whitfield managed to see beyond the dire state of their house in north Essex when they first viewed it in 2012. 'Someone was living in part of the property, but it was dated and rundown, and needed everything doing,' says Kate. 'In spite of all that, I fell in love with the period features, high ceilings and good light.'

'Renovation is in my line of business, so I wasn't too worried about having to do all the work,' says Kate, who has her own interior design company, An Artful Life (anartfullife.co.uk). The couple got cracking straightaway, drawing up plans and choosing a builder from a shortlist of three local companies, so the work started just before Christmas that year.

'The kitchen is in an extension at the back that was like a shed,' says Kate. 'It had no foundations and there was a narrow scullery leading off it. We wanted to create a large, light-filled kitchen-diner, so our first job was to demolish the existing room and extend properly. We knocked down a wall to open up the scullery and part of the staircase and hallway to create one large room. We chose bifold doors to maximise the light and in summer we open them straight onto the garden.'

Kate and Andrew turned a room leading off the kitchen into a more formal dining room for themselves after the twins are in bed, and for entertaining. 'It's perfect as a family house,' says Kate. 'You need an adult space once the children have gone off to bed, so you're not just picking up toys all the time. Now the house is finished, much as I love the new space at the back, I think I like the living room the best. It's homely and comfortable, but also a little bit quirky. It's where we can all relax together as a family.'
















Mix modern and vintage elements

'Our new kitchen island was built bespoke to fit with an old butcher's block we already owned. The island hides the appliances and I like the way the light bounces off the marble.'



irst-time buyers Suzie Johnson and Andrew Hill climbed onto the property ladder by taking on a house that needed top-to-toe renovation. In its favour were great views from its hilltop position and the fact that Suzie's sister and mum live just minutes away. But transforming the terrace, located in the village of Withnell, Lancashire, took 17 months of hard work.

'It was badly designed,' says Suzie. 'The kitchen had red and white gloss units with black worktops, combined with yellow and purple walls. The bathroom had a blue carpet and a bidet, and the cupboard holding the water tank was in the middle of the room.'

The couple planned to make big changes. 'We didn't need more space, as there were four separate rooms on the ground floor,' says Suzie, 'so it was more a case of making the existing layout work harder and flow better.' To achieve this, a dilapidated conservatory was removed and an extension was built on its footprint to create an open-plan kitchen-diner. 'We gave it two big windows and two skylights, as well as enlarging an existing window, which has really brightened up the middle part of the house,' adds Suzie.

Upstairs, the couple knocked two small bedrooms together to create a large main bedroom. There was already another bedroom in the loft, so they felt that losing one wouldn't devalue the property. The entire house also had to be rewired and replastered, and a new heating system and flooring were installed.

'It took three times as long and cost three times as much as I originally thought it would, but I've learnt so much!' says Suzie. 'We have no plans to move, but I'd love to do it all again one day.'

'Everyone comments on our reclaimed radiators,' says Suzie. 'We chose different shapes for each room and customised them with different colours, and either nickel or copper valves to tie in with each scheme.'







HOW LILY DID IT

'The builders I chose spent time going through every single detail with me. They were a bit more expensive, but I knew they would care about the project. The project took four months, with all the building, design and installation coming in at £53,000. The extractors on my neighbour's extension, which forms part of our party wall, meant we couldn't build as high

as planned, so we moved the units to the other side and you can see that the walls are different heights. But the light is amazing – bright in summer and cosy in winter. I reasoned that dark grey-black units would go with anything, so it meant I had freedom with the rest of the kitchen. Doing it on my own was daunting, but I'm so proud of how it came together.'

HOW ANNA AND GREG DID IT

'It took 18 months for us to get planning permission for a 6m two-storey rear and side extension. We worked with Juttla Architects, but it was all Greg's design – he runs a building company, Smart Conversion, and had a vision for what he wanted to achieve. ANNA'S CHOICE: CONCRETE FLOORING

Fallen hard for the Horodenskis' smart polished concrete floor? Find out if it's right for your home with our guide...

With its industrial looks and hard-wearing and easy-to-clean qualities, it's little wonder polished concrete flooring has become popular in homes. It holds heat well, too, so it's a good choice if you want to install underfloor heating.

What exactly is polished concrete flooring?

Very simply, it is concrete, left in its raw state or coloured, which has been polished and sealed to create a nonporous surface. It is commonly polished to a grit level of 800, 1,500 or 3,000 - the higher the level, the shinier the floor. Costs vary from £80-£450 per sq m, depending on whether it is levelled by machine or trowelled by hand, and any extra work dedicated to avoiding cracks.

How is it installed? Techniques vary, but most polished concrete floors are poured in a single 10cm-thick layer. The next day, expansion cuts are sawn into the floor, encouraging inevitable shrinkage cracks to form in a neat line. These are then filled with an expandable, colour-matched sealant. Finally, the floor is cleaned, polished and sealed.

Does it take long to install? It depends on the size and temperature of the room, plus the method chosen, but allow around seven to 10 days for a 10cm-thick floor. It will need to be resealed once a year to keep it waterproof.

Will it crack? It's possible, but many people

love the pattern of fine lines. Using shrink-reducing additives will minimise the risk of larger cracks. Sudden temperature changes are the main cause of cracks, so it's important to introduce heating, particularly underfloor, slowly.

Can you retro-fit it? It's far easier to install concrete in a new-build or an extension, where it can go down before the skirting boards and doors are fitted. A micro-concrete floor (a coating that can be applied to wood or tiles) might prove easier if you are installing it in an existing room of your house.





MELANIE'S CHOICE: OBSCURED GLASS

If your bathroom's overlooked or you want to disguise a less-than-perfect view, there are plenty of options available

Lack of privacy, an awkwardlyshaped window or a steamy bathroom can leave you looking for an alternative to bathroom blinds. Replacing clear glass with obscured glass might offer a more practical solution.

What's the popular option? Textured glass – a rolled, patterned glass with the design impressed onto one side of the surface. It makes the glass translucent and non-transparent, distorting views while also letting in plenty of light. Designs vary from simple ripples and reeded lines to more decorative florals, foliage and geometrics and there are several different gradings available, according to the privacy level (or obscuration) required.

QI'm not keen on a textured finish – what else is there?

Try sandblasted or acid-etched glass. Both use abrasives to create a frosted look that gives privacy and diffuses the light. You can choose the level of opacity, from a light frosting to fully opaque, and either an all-over treatment or a patterned effect. Acid etching is a specialist technique so tends to be pricier, while sandblasting can

create lots of different effects but is prone to finger marks. Designs vary from standard geometrics to your own bespoke sketch.

What about colour?
A stained glass window
treatment is a great way of adding
colour. Made using sections of
glass held together with leading,
designs vary from a simple border
or coloured insets to decorative
period patterns. Choose from
standard designs or commission

(British Society of Master Glass Painters) for a list of members.

How can I do it on a budget?
An inexpensive alternative is

your own - visit bsmpg.org.uk

vinyl film that you apply yourself. It comes in frosted, patterned, coloured and stained glass effects, and can be ordered cut to size. The film must be applied to clean glass and positioned onto the window using a squeegee. Prices start at around £30 for a 100cm panel.



Take a quick tour...



hen Mel and Roy Fletcher realised they couldn't live in their small, poorly insulated park home in the New Forest National Park any longer, it was time to take action. But buying a house in the area was beyond their budget and replacing their home wasn't possible, as planning permission stopped new houses being built in a Greenfield Conservation Area.

FINDING A SOLUTION However, there was a third option: 'There had been two caravans on the site since 1963 – ours and our neighbour's,' says Mel. 'Because of this precedent, we were sure we could seek planning permission for a new mobile home.'

THE BRIEF 'We approached local architects PAD Studio to discuss building a bespoke home as we really liked other buildings they've designed in the area,' says Mel. Architect Wendy Perring explains, 'The design had to comply with the Caravan Act 1968, which restricts the construction and size of the dwelling. The aim with Forest Lodge was to create a light-filled, low-energy home with a strong connection to the surrounding landscape. Importantly, Mel and Roy didn't want their new dwelling to resemble or feel like a mobile home.'

THE RESULT The new house was prefabricated and fitted out in Yorkshire and arrived after five months, in two parts, on flatbed trucks. It was lifted by crane onto the existing concrete and limestone foundation. Once in place, the building was bolted together and finished from there, with all the joints taped to ensure full airtightness. Clad in vertical chestnut boards, the steel-frame structure includes an open-plan living, dining and kitchen area and two en-suite bedrooms, one of which doubles up as a study. 'Although Forest Lodge may be built to a restricted size, we don't feel it's a compromise. It suits our needs perfectly,' says Mel.

RIGHT Full-height windows have been strategically placed to maximise sunlight and views throughout the property. Bespoke joinery that clears the floor adds to the airy feel in the bedroom ABOVE RIGHT 'We wanted something contemporary and homely but not too white in the kitchen, so we chose a mix of white lacquered units, limestone worktops and oak finishes,' says Mel

IN PARTNERSHIP WITH VELUX

We swapped brick walls for glass'

The Grieves cleverly extended their period house with a simple glass garden room

hen Carol and Drew Grieve moved into their Arts and Crafts house in Glasgow, it had been relatively untouched. 'The ground floor had three separate rooms, with very little connection to the garden,' says Carol.

FINDING INSPIRATION

A trip to The Netherlands gave the couple the idea for a frameless glazed extension. 'We saw a Japanese-inspired garden pavilion, with seamless glazing and canopy by Ewan Cameron Architects and loved it,' says Carol. 'It was perfect for our idea of an open-plan kitchen-diner with a link to the living room and garden.'

LINKING THE SPACE

The couple settled on an elegant construction of frameless solar glazing, with a white canopy and dark zinc roofing, which had to be supported by three steel beams. 'The idea is that you move through the early 20th-century living room at the front of the house via Modernistinspired glazed sliding doors, facings and architraves to the 21st-century extension,' says Carol. 'It's a subtle transition where nothing jars.'

THE RESULT

'It's changed the way we live,' says Carol. 'Sitting in our extension feels like being in the garden and the glass floods the ground floor with light making it a more sociable space.'



ackling the garden was the end of a two-year house renovation for Alasdair and Philippa Beaumont. 'We'd left it until last so that we had a place to store all the building materials – it was a dumping ground,' says Philippa.

Overlooked by neighbours, the garden measured just 7.60m x 4.60m and had beds around the edges that made it seem even smaller. 'It felt very uninviting, with damaged crazy paving, and was horribly overgrown,' says Philippa. 'Its only saving graces were its original red-brick Victorian walls and a tall hedge at the bottom.'

The couple set aside a budget of £5,000 for a professional to tackle the project. 'You wouldn't blink at spending thousands on a bathroom, so we see this as an investment,' says Philippa. 'We worked out a budget, which included all the materials plus a contingency for plants.' The job went to Harry and David Rich of Rich Landscapes (07779 786823; richlandscapes. net). 'They understood immediately that we wanted a garden for dining and entertaining, and that we also needed more privacy,' says Philippa. 'We wanted to maximise the space and were excited by their ideas to include tree ferns and create two separate areas within the garden. Including Alasdair, there was a team of eight who completed the entire transformation in just two days. Now the garden is totally unrecognisable!'







Home-made barbecue sauce

Takes 25min Makes 600ml

INGREDIENTS • 2 shallots, peeled • 10 garlic cloves, peeled • 2 red chillies, trimmed • 3tbsp olive oil • 8 sprigs of fresh rosemary, leaves only • 2tbsp fennel seeds • 2tbsp smoked paprika • 3tbsp soy sauce • Zest and juice of 2 lemons

- 1tbsp mustard powder
- Itbsp illustatu powde
- 150g soft brown sugar
- 225ml tomato ketchup175ml orange or apple
- juice Sea salt and pepper

Whizz all the ingredients in a blender until combined. Place in a saucepan, bring to the boil, then simmer for 15min. Once cool, pour into a sterilised jar and keep in the fridge for up to a month. Use as a marinade for meat.

The best barbecue rub

Takes 2min Makes 240g

INGREDIENTS • 50g smoked paprika • 50g sea salt • 15g mild or hot chilli powder • 25g crushed coriander seeds • 50g freshly ground black pepper • 50g soft brown sugar

Mix all the ingredients together in a bowl, then transfer to an airtight container. Store for up to two months. This dry rub can be used on any meat – try it with ribs or chicken.



BLT dogs

Takes 20min Serves 6

INGREDIENTS • 12

bacon-wrapped chipolatas
• 2 baguettes, cut into thirds
• ½ lettuce, shredded • 30
cherry tomatoes, quartered

• Mayonnaise, to serve

Grill the chipolatas until cooked through. Put two into each piece of baguette, along with some lettuce and tomatoes. Top with mayo.

Midwest dogs

Takes 20min Serves 6

INGREDIENTS • 6 sausages • 6 sub rolls, toasted • 200g sauerkraut • Caraway seeds • American-style mustard, to serve

Grill the sausages until cooked. Fill each roll with a sausage, some sauerkraut and a sprinkling of caraway seeds. Top with mustard.

Cowboy dogs

Takes 20min Serves 6

INGREDIENTS • 6 sausages • 2 onions, sliced • 1tbsp sunflower oil • 6 sub rolls, toasted • 150g Monterey Jack cheese, grated • Ketchup or barbecue sauce, to serve

Grill the sausages until cooked. Fry the onions in the oil, until crispy. Fill each roll with a sausage and onions, then top with cheese and your choice of sauce.



Vegetable & potato salad

Takes 30min Serves 6

INGREDIENTS • 750g
new potatoes, boiled • 3tbsp
sun-drenched tomatoes, oil
reserved • Zest and juice
1 lemon • 1tsp sherry vinegar
• 2 courgettes, sliced • 6
spring onions, halved • 2tbsp
olive oil • 2tbsp chilli pepper
pearls • 10g cress, snipped

Toss the boiled potatoes in 2tbsp oil from the tomatoes, the lemon zest and juice, and the vinegar. In a separate bowl, toss the courgettes and onions in the olive oil, then grill on the barbecue. Mix the potatoes with the grilled vegetables, tomatoes, pepper pearls and cress.

Ranch pasta salad

Takes 20min Serves 6

INGREDIENTS • 1tbsp
mayonnaise • 100ml
buttermilk • 1tbsp soured
cream • 1tbsp chives,
chopped • 1 garlic clove,
grated • 1tsp vinegar • 2 corn
on the cobs • 1tsp vegetable
oil • 120g cubed pancetta
• 250g pasta, cooked

• 3 spring onions, chopped

Mix the first six ingredients together well. Fry the corn in the oil, set aside, then fry the pancetta until it's crisp. Slice the corn off the cob and mix all the salad ingredients together with the dressing.



King prawns with Thai dipping sauce

Takes 20min Serves 6

INGREDIENTS • 3 garlic cloves, finely crushed • 2tbsp fresh ginger, finely grated •1 lemongrass stalk, outer layer removed and inner layer finely chopped • 1 red chilli, finely chopped • 1tbsp palm sugar or soft brown sugar • 2tbsp rice wine vinegar • 2tbsp sov sauce • 1tsp sesame oil Large handful of coriander leaves, finely chopped • 24 large shell-on king prawns • 1tbsp oil • Sea salt • 1 lime, quartered, to serve

To make the dipping sauce, put the garlic, ginger, lemongrass, chilli, sugar, rice wine vinegar, soy sauce, sesame oil and coriander leaves with 2tbsp water in a small bowl, mix until well combined, then set aside. Toss the prawns in the oil and cook in a medium-hot pan or on the barbecue for 3min on each side, or until they turn pink. Serve on a tray with a sprinkle of sea salt, the lime wedges and the dipping sauce.
